FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR YOUR DRY JULY WORKPLACE TEAM





1. MIX UP A MOCKTAIL OR TWO

With so many great non-alcoholic spirits, beers and wines now available in stores and online, you can easily create some tasty mocktail creations for your workplace.

Think of some creative mocktail names and get mixing your alcohol-free concoctions.

Your workmates draw the task and do it for you without revealing who has completed it. Job done!



5. OFFICE CAR WASH

Fill a jar with bottle caps (you can find these online or at selected large grocery retailers) and start a guessing competition. \$2 per guess.

7. DRY JULY SOUP KITCHEN
